*Want to use hoof boots? We will offer standard ride awards in a class for horses using hoof boots that don't meet current NATRC requirements (boots that come above the coronet band). We will call this the "Booted class" and these horses will accumulate NATRC mileage as DO riders, but will not receive points toward regional or national NATRC annual awards. We kindly ask those competing in this class to complete a short survey. If you just want to try NATRC and not compete, we also have our regular Distance Only option that also accumulates NATRC mileage, but not ride, regional or national awards or points.

GENERAL INFORMATION: The camp is semi-primitive. You must bring your own people water. Horse water is from either the pond or the windmill tank. There are two permanent toilets – no showers or electrical hookups. Volunteers will be fed starting Friday night. (P/R crews, safety riders, etc). Riders are responsible for feeding themselves. Office will open for check-in at 2:00 PM Friday Sept 3, 2010. POT LUCK on SATURDAY NIGHT! Bring a dish, join the fun!

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS: Negative Coggins is required (ORIGINAL) on ALL equine in camp, bring to office at check in. Current health certificate or passport is required to cross TX state line. Smoking on the trail will be limited according to weather conditions and forest service requirements. Dogs allowed in camp On Leash Only And Must Be Confined To Your Camp. Forest Service May Write Tickets For Loose Dogs! Please keep all alcoholic beverages confined to your campsite. All trash MUST be carried out with you. Horse manure and hay waste must be neatly scattered.

ENTRIES FEES

A Ride: Adult \$70.00 Junior \$45 B Ride: Adult \$50 Junior \$35 Distance Only entries are the same. Entries accepted June 1, 2010 or after. Late fee after closing date: August 27, 2010 is \$10.00. Add \$10.00 camp fee (for 2 nights) for every horse. Note other fees on entry form. Contact us for an entry form to be emailed.

The following rules are an effort to encourage full payment with your entries: If you send full payment and cancel before the closing date, you will receive a full refund. Cancellations after the closing date and before 8 PM on September 3rd pay a \$30 office fee. If you pay only a \$30 deposit and cancel at any time, you will forfeit your deposit. No-shows forfeit all payments (exceptions may be made for emergency situations). Make checks payable to: Critter Creek Therapeutic Riding Fund (CCTRF). Send copy of horse registration to compete for Breed Awards (if awards are donated). Directions from 380 to Camp In Decatur Hwy 380 to FM 730 (signs also say Airport) then go north 9.5 mile to CR 2461 (sign will also say Cemetery), 100 yards turn right on CR 2560 follow CR 2560 2.3 mile to road 900 (sign will say Cottonwood Lake) turn left it is then 1.8 miles to camp at TADRA Point. Directions from Fort Worth: I-35W north to US-287 then northwest on US-287 to US-380. Turn east less than a mile to FM 730. Proceed as above. Directions from Oklahoma: I-35 south to Highway 380 West [just north of Denton] to Decatur. From SW OK or NW TX: Take US 287 South to Decatur and turn East on 380 and proceed as above. Call or email Jean for the short cut directions from Alvord.
