Celebrate the end of summer and enjoy the scenic beauty of Parrie Haynes Ranch with all the comforts of a resort, including a swimming pool! The terrain is varied with grassy two-track lanes, single track cedar breaks and rocky bluffs. Shoes or boots highly recommended.

General Information: Electric hook-ups available on first **fully paid fees**, first served basis. **Camping fees as deposits are non-refundable.** Bunkhouse with showers are also available and require non-refundable deposits as well. Non-management volunteers receive primitive camping for free. Quiet hours will be observed, weather-permitting. Horse water in camp, but hosing will be restricted. Bring your own people water. Check-in will begin at 2 pm Friday although Registration also accepted on day of competition by 6:30 am; vet checks at 7 am. Time out onto the trail promptly at 7:30 am each day.

Meals: Friday evening cook-out with sides, watermelon and chips **free for all**, then bring your own meat to grill AND a dish to share at the potluck dinner on Saturday evening.

General Requirements: Proof of a negative Coggins (originals only) must be submitted on the ranch road prior to entry to the campgrounds. All NATRC stabling options allowed. Tree savers must be used. Smoking on the trail is prohibited. Manure and hay may be discarded over the bank. Dogs are permitted in camp; however, they **MUST BE ON LEASHES AT ALL TIMES – NO EXCEPTIONS!** No dogs allowed at meetings or meals. Bag all trash and take it with you.

Directions: From the North: Take 190 to 195 South to right on FM 2670. Travel 3.7 miles and turn right onto Maxdale Road. Travel .3 miles and turn left onto Gann Branch Road. Continue on dirt road, cross cattle guard onto paved road and bear left at “T”. Follow paved road into camp. From the South, take 195 North to left onto FM 2670 and continue as above.

Ride Entry Fees

Adult “A” Two-day Entry Open/Novice/CP: \$105.00 (**Members subtract \$20**)

Junior “A” Two-day Entry: \$85.00 (**Members subtract \$20**)

All “B” One-day Entries: \$90.00 (**Members subtract \$20**)

Note: Family discounts available for second non-junior family member

Camping Fees

\$25 per night for electric hook-up (\$40 for two nights; \$20 each additional night)

\$15 per night for bunkhouse use

\$15 per night for primitive camping

\$10 for day-rider with no overnight camping (Ranch Fee)

\$10 per night for those competitors sharing a rig (Ranch Fee)
